7. IT'S SHOW TIME

Hampstead Garden Suburb, London, £15.75m, arlingtonresidential.com

Rivalling a car museum's ambience and lavish attention to detail, this eight-car garage/showroom, currently housing a Lamborghini Huracan, a Ferrari 328 and a Chevrolet Corvette Stingray to name just a few - belongs to a 10,000sq ft contemporary house in north London. It features professionalquality display lighting, showing the cars to their very best, and even more impressively, the garage can be viewed from the games/entertainment room via two floor-to-ceiling glass walls - providing a 40ft-wide viewing gallery. It is accessed via an ultra-secure car lift with a turning circle, polished concrete flooring with drainage and a bank of 18 video screens.

'The current owners, who are car enthusiasts, purchased the house several years ago and then rebuilt it behind the existing façade – in which they created a spectacular underground car showroom,' Marc Schneiderman, director of Arlington Residential says. 'One of the most exciting things about the garage, which is 70ft deep and 40ft wide, is that it's completely unexpected and the exterior of the house gives no clue as to the showroom's existence.'

Royce and has four secure electric doors, extra security and all the power and lighting an enthusiast could ask for.

The well-lit workbench, which runs along the entire width of the back wall, features ultra-modern, built-in storage, with black cabinet doors and chrome handles. The current owner has also set up a pillar drill, bench grinder and coffee machine in this workspace.

The garage also boasts full-length strip lighting, polished floors with drainage and panelled walls with artwork for a contemporary, snug feel. There's also a handy office area with glass-panelled doors, metal cabinets and an L-shaped desk with great views of the garage - ideal for spending hours googling the next project/ performance parts.



10. REVV-ELATION Charlton Kings,

Set well back from the road behind electric gates, this eightbedroom property's sweeping drive, provides ample parking for a string of vehicles, and leads to a newly-built garage with a self-contained apartment in the loft with open-plan sitting room/kitchen, double bedroom and bathroom.
